Accessibility Policy and Plan

Aims

This policy and plan has been established to ensure all pupils; regardless of disability have equality of opportunity to the school buildings, curriculum and information.

Background information

Christ Church School was extended in 2001 and 2004 and disabled access was improved. Adaptations to the building have also taken place to ensure access for pupils with special needs.

The School will ensure that further development will address the needs of all pupils regardless of disability.

Adaptations carried out to make the building accessible.

- 1. All external doors have a wide opening to ensure easy access.
- 2. Reception hatch has been lowered so it is accessible for wheel chair users.
- 3. Lift installed to provide access to the hall
- 4. Disabled toilet fitted with alarm
- 5. Classroom 14 fitted with a hearing loop
- 6. Reception fitted with a hearing loop
- 7. Adjustable table available
- 8. Ramping to most doors including the hall
