2023-2024 proposed spend

1. Progressive sport curriculum support

Progressive Sports to provide curriculum support x6 weekly for the Autumn term. This will support teaching knowledge within games and PE across the school.

Ideally we would like this to continue into the spring term too.

Spend: £6,000.

2. Sports workshops – linked to the Olympics

Workshops across school booked with an ex-Olympian visiting school

Spend: £1,000

3. Forest Schools sessions for Year 5 children

Children in Year 5 will have 6 Forest School sessions to develop their outdoor/survival skills.

Spend: £2000

4. PE equipment update.

Table football tables, football goals and other PE equipment ordered.

Spend: £1000

5. Lunchtime and clubs after school

Children have the opportunity to work with a sports coach, teaching them new sports and new skills both at lunchtime and after school.

Spend: £2000

6. Small group sport-based nurture groups:

PB sports have delivered lunchtime clubs and nurture/EAL groups on a Monday and Friday to support identified children with social/emotional difficulties and language barriers.

Spend: £2000

Total Spend: £14,000

In addition – supported by school budget and parental contributions

1. Forest Schools across the school.

All year groups will be given the opportunity to participate in Forest School sessions. This was extremely successful last year and using the Sports Premium Grant we are able to provide it again for the children this year. It allows the children to access this outdoor/adventurous activity, along with working alongside their parents/carers for half a day.

Spend: £4000

2. Intra-sports tournaments
