

Which door do I use in the morning & when I go home?

- You will need to arrive at school between 8.40am and 8.55am and come into school via the hall door.
- School finishes at 3.20pm and you will leave school via the same door.



What do I need to bring to school with me?

- **School bag:** Please make sure this isn't too big as it will need to fit inside your locker.
- **Water bottle:** This will need to be named and should only contain water.
- **Stationery:** All of the stationery you need will be given to you by your teachers.
- **Art Shirt:** Please bring in a large shirt in a named bag that can be used during Art activities. This will stay in your locker.
- **Spare clothes:** We know accidents can happen, please bring in some spare pants and bottoms that can be left in your locker.



How do Reading Books get changed in Year 1?

- You will be given a reading book to take home and read with an adult. Please make sure you bring this into school, with your reading record, each day.
- You will also have an online reading book through Bug Club. Your login details for Bug Club will be in the front of your reading record.
- Your class teacher will change your reading book every week.
