

Which door do I use in the morning & when I go home?

- You will need to arrive at school between 8.40am and 8.55am and come in via the door next to the shelter and lost property.
- School finishes at 3.20pm and you will leave school via the same door.



What do I need to bring to school with me?

- **School bag:** Please make sure this isn't too big as it will need to fit inside your locker.
- **Water bottle:** This will need to be named and should only contain water.
- **Stationery:** All of the stationery you need will be given to you by your teachers.
- **Art Shirt:** Please bring in a large shirt in a named carrier bag that can be used during Art activities. This will stay in your locker.



What will Maths and English groups be like in Year 3?

- The groups in Year 3 may change quite frequently. This is so both teachers can teach you.
