Wright Brothers – Significant Figure




The Wright Brothers Impacted society by Creating the First plane, introducing a new mode of transportation to mankind, and changed the way aerodynamics works.

stands on the beach in Kitty Hawk,
North Carolina, staring at the sky
above him. Soaring overhead in an
airplane is his brother Orville—
he's in the middle of the world's
first successful piloted enginepowered airplane flight which
lasted 12 seconds.

Ole Christiansen developed one of the most popular construction toys of the modern day.

Ole Christiansen

- Ole Kirk Christiansen was Danish entrepreneur who found fortune in toys. Born on April 7 in 1891, in Denmark, he became famous and wealthy as the founder of The Lego Group.



He owned a small shop and he began by creating small wooden duck toys for his children to play with. He noticed how much his children loved the toys so he started making more of them and sold them to other children. Wooden toys such as piggy banks, pull toys, cars and trucks and houses became the main products of his shop until in 1934, he adopted the brand name Lego which is now one of the most popular toys.
