Inter-related dimensions

Pulse: is a steady beat like a ticking clock or your heart beat.

Dynamics: how loud or quiet a sound is.

Pitch: how high or low a sound is.

Tempo: how fast or slow a note/ piece of music

is.

Rhythm: a pattern of long or short sounds.

Instruments

In Year 1, we will speak, sing and chant with our voices. We will also practise clapping to a pulse and will begin to learn to play the glockenspiel.




Notation

We are learning to read and draw sounds using pictures, which are also called **graphic notation.**



Notes on a Glockenspiel

The longer notes are lower and the shorter notes are higher pitched.
