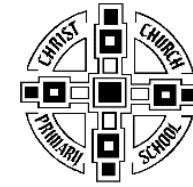




Religious Education

Old Testament – Stories about the people of Israel whom God wanted to save.





New Testament – Stories about Jesus.

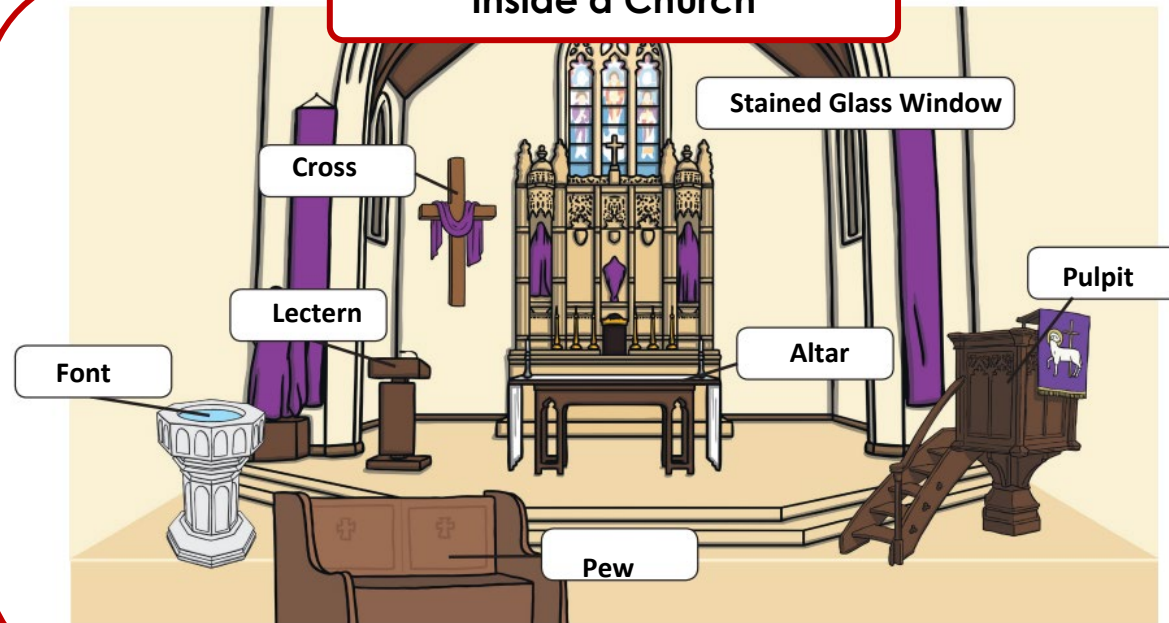
The Holy Trinity The father, son and the Holy Spirit make up the three parts of God.	
	
The Father	Christian people believe that God is the father of Jesus.
The Son	Christians believe that Jesus is the son of God. They believe that Jesus died on the cross and came back to life to save them
The Holy spirit	This is how God can be with us all of the time – his spirit and energy.

	The cross is a special Christian symbol. It reminds Christians of the place Jesus died.
	Candles represent that Jesus is the light of the world.
	This is our church – Christ Church. A church is a place where Christians go to worship.
	This is a Bible – the Christian Holy Book.

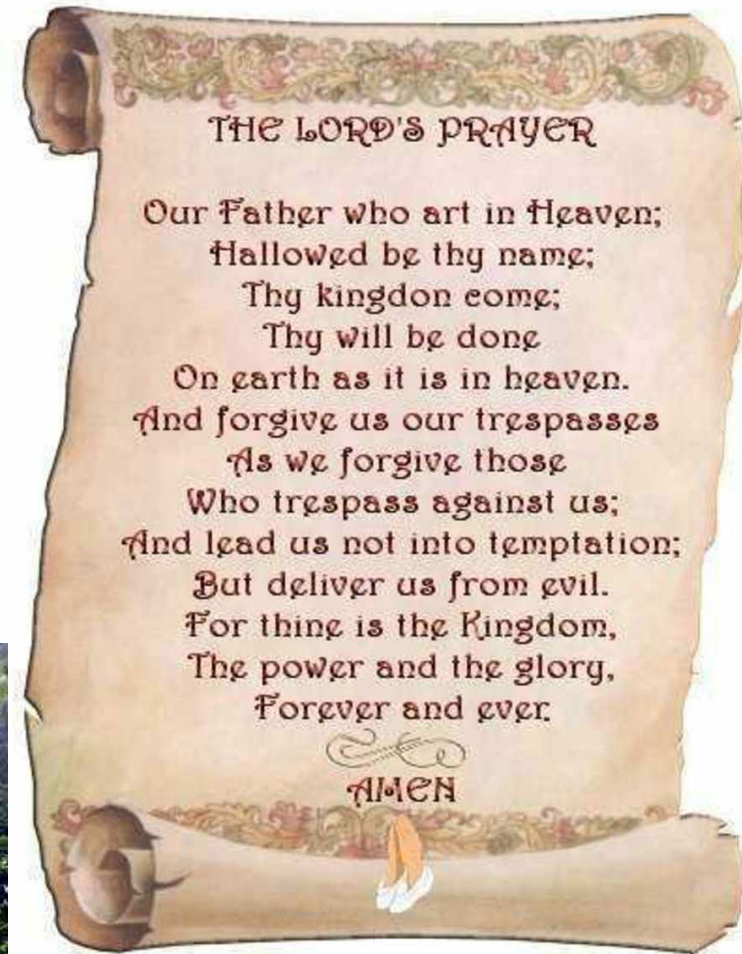
The Disciples were followers of Jesus who spread Christianity.
